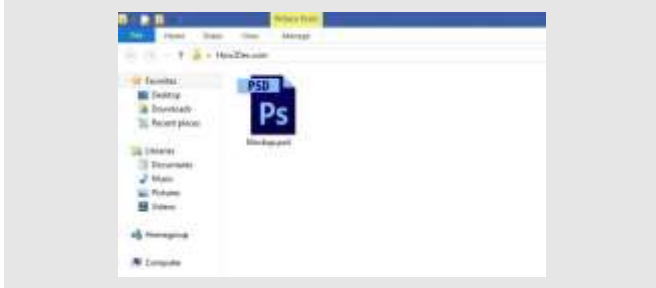

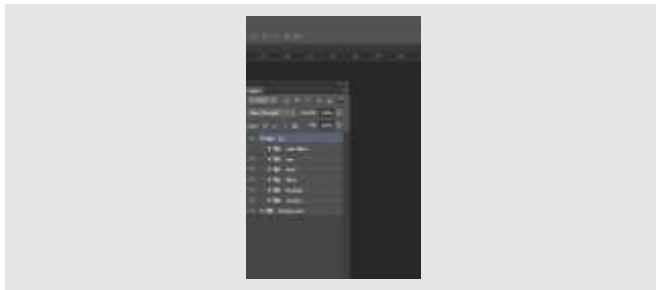
Learning How to Edit with Photoshop

Step 1

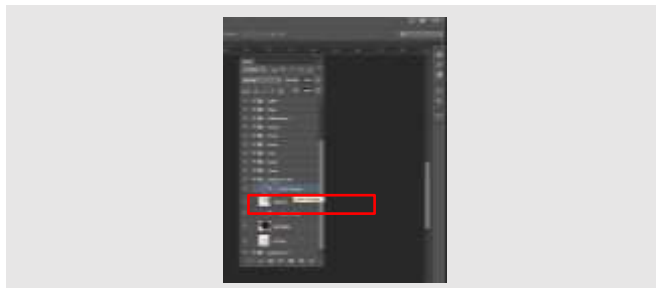
Open the PSD file.



Step 2

The files in the folder PSD are all well organised with layers which are for ease of finding which elements you need to edit.

In the template, go to Window > Layers.



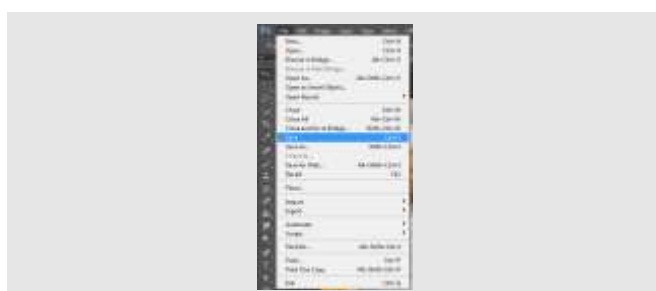
Step 3

To change the color of an item, double click on the layer that you want to replace.



Step 4

A new window will open where you can change the color of an object as you like.



Step 5

After editing and replacing just go to File and click save the work [Ctrl+s].
The mockup should be automatically updated
